Carlton

A large cupped daffodil, two-toned yellow, with a darker yellow trumpet (or cup) set in a lighter yellow perianth.

Has a vanilla fragrance and is renowned for its hardiness and ability to become perennial anywhere.

Known as the 'World' most popular daffodil." 17" tall.



Fortune

A light orange cup with a bright yellow perianth.

Very good as a perennial. 17" tall.



Flower Record

A large cupped daffodil, ivory white with gold\orange cup.

Very good for naturalizing. 13" Tall.



Tete a Tete

A 'specie' daffodil suitable for the front of a border.
One to three yellow\dark-yellow cupped flowers per stem
on 6" stems.



Hawera

A 'triandrus' daffodil, 12 – 15" tall with many
lemon yellow blooms. A good naturalizer.



Chionodoxa luciliae

Gentian blue flowers with white centers on 8" stems.
A super naturalizer, great layered with daffodils.



Scilla siberica

Brilliant porcelain blue, producing masses of colour
in early spring. 6 – 8" tall. Spreads to form a ground cover.
